This form is a legal document that is used by Alberta Education to verify enrollment and ensure the information the school has is up to date. We are required to have Parents / Guardians complete this form for each student annually in the Fall. If you are receiving emails regarding this form, that means yours is currently incomplete.

This form is accessible using SchoolEngage via the PowerSchool Parent Portal. Please login to your PowerSchool Parent Portal on a web browser (NOT the app) using this link: PowerSchool Public Portal

To complete the **RDCRS Student Information Update Form** for the current school year, click on **School Engage** (on the **bottom left)**. A list of incomplete forms should appear in the **Home** tab, under the heading **Notifications**.

1 Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:

SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
